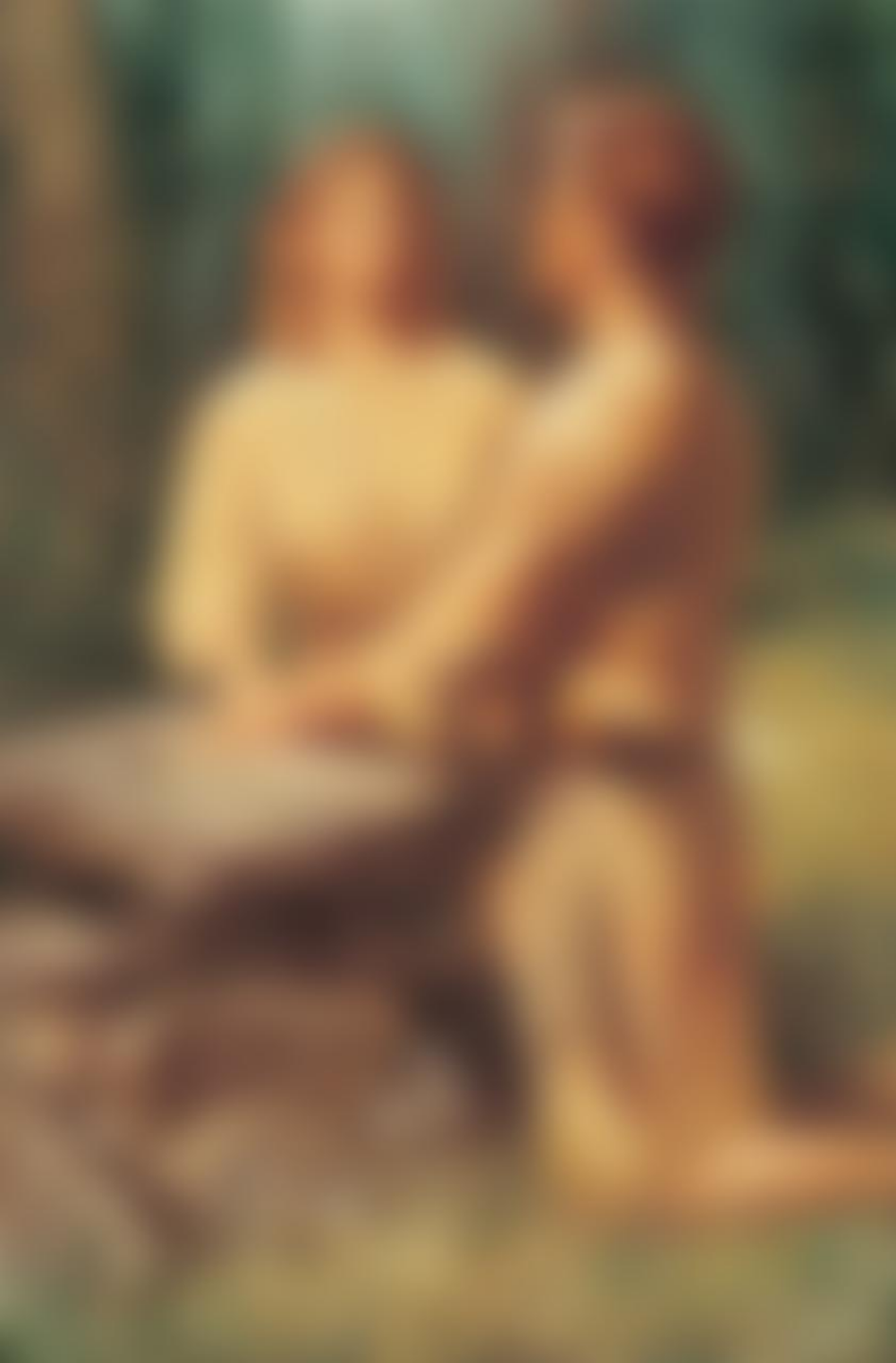


This Old Testament

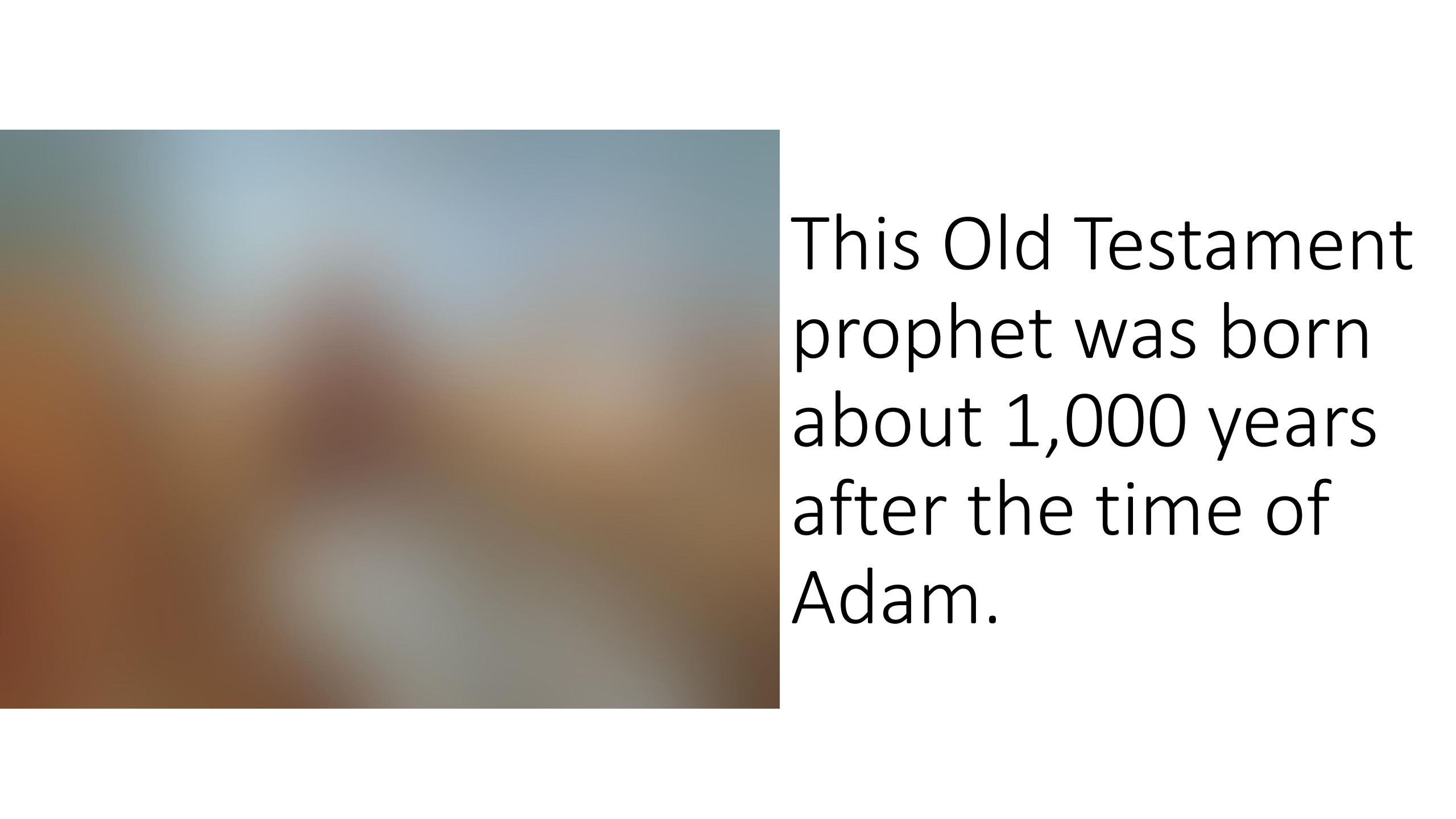

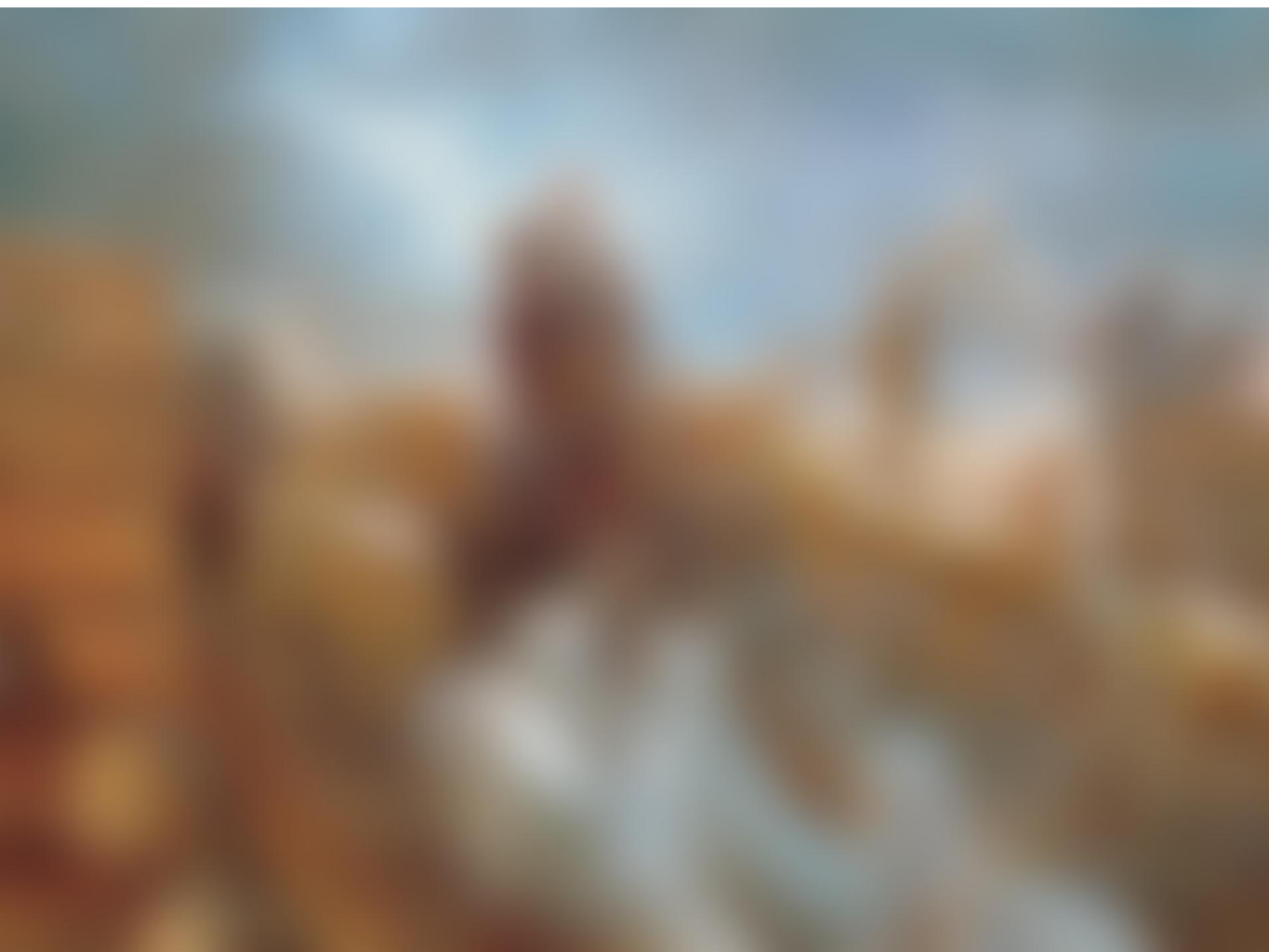

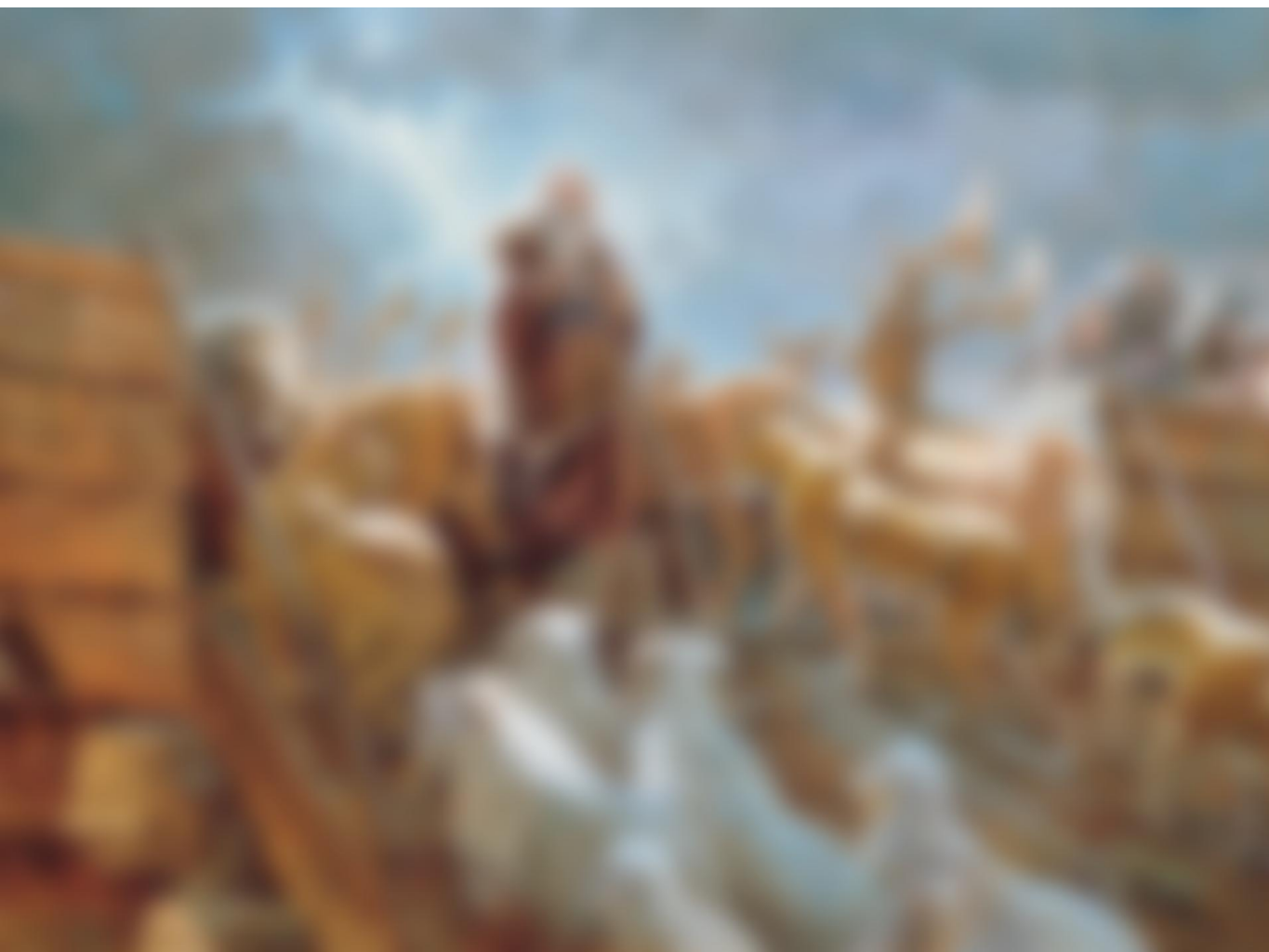

This Old Testament prophet was the son of Lamech and grandson of Methuselah.



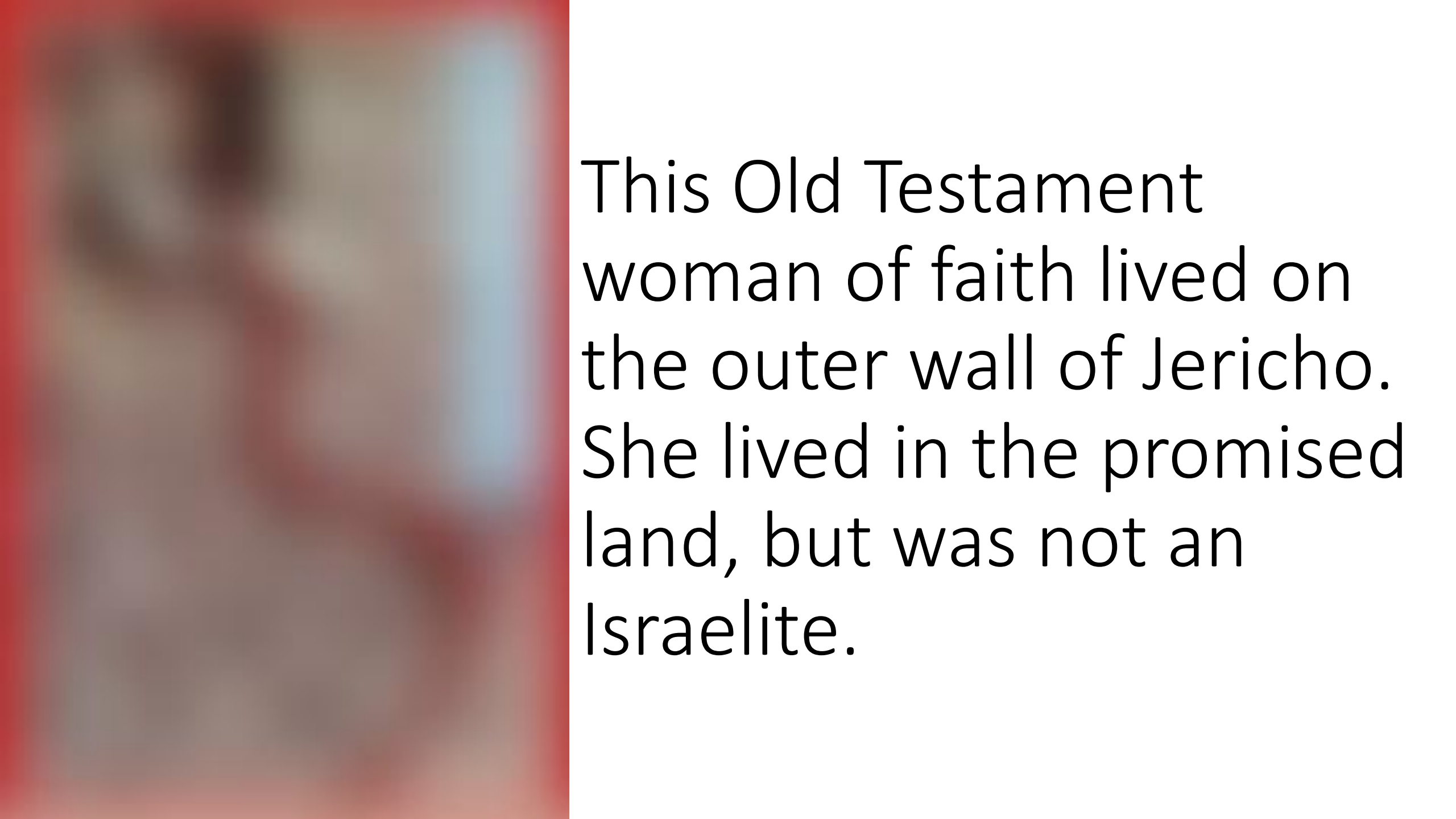
This Old Testament prophet spent 120 years preaching repentance and building a ship.

Israelite.

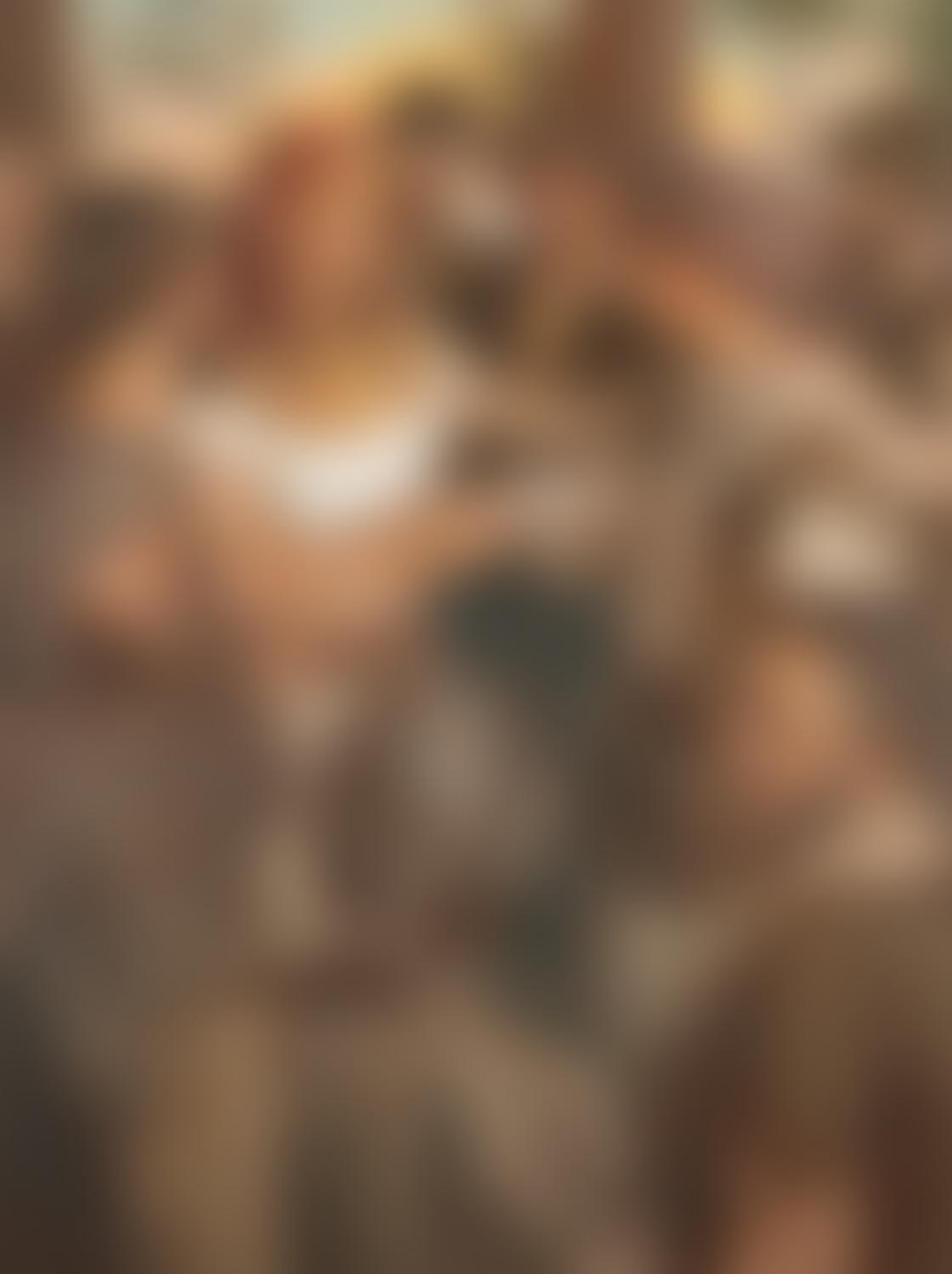


This Old Testament woman of faith saved herself, her family, and helped Joshua and his armies through her faith.

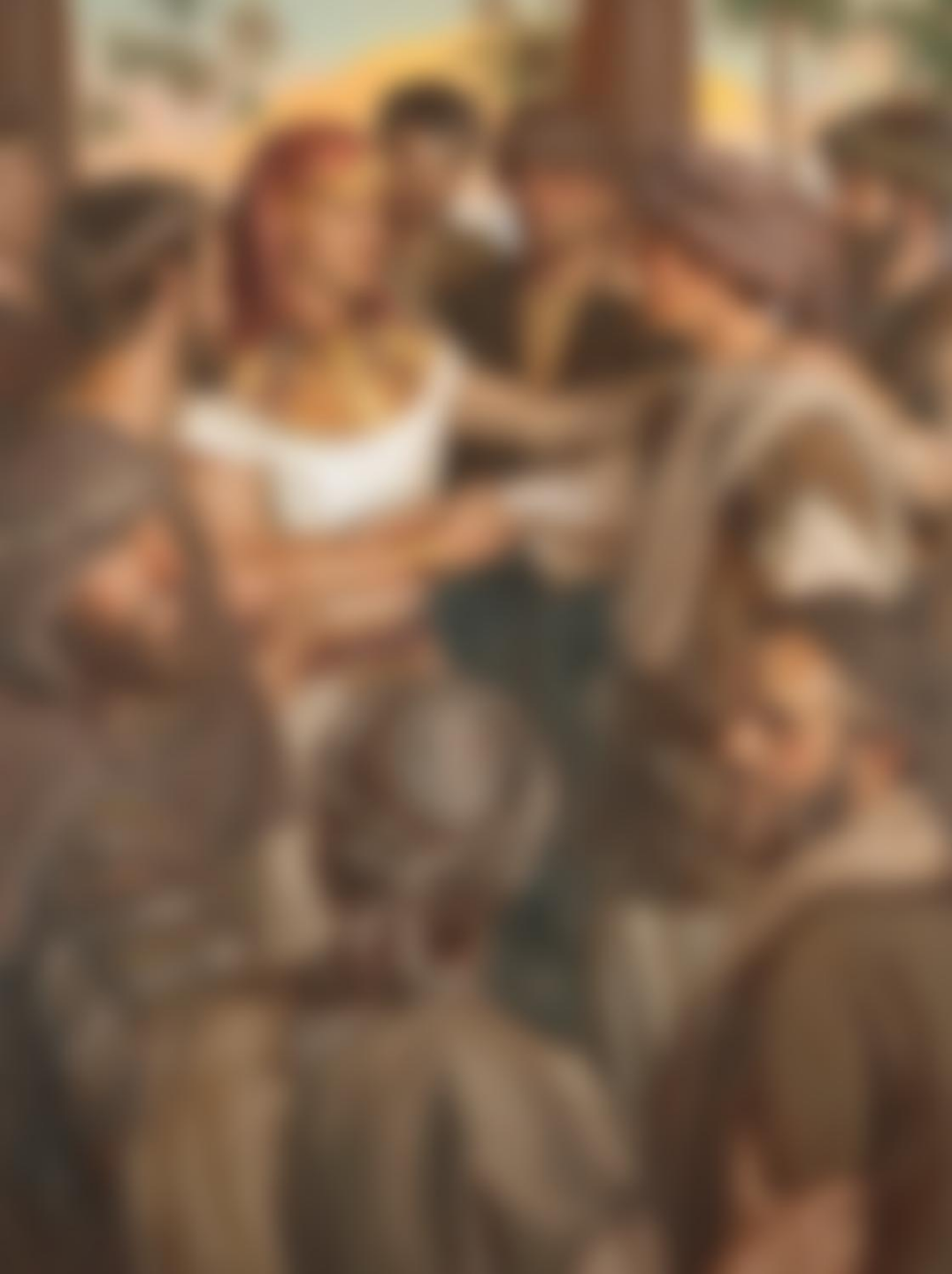

RAHAB

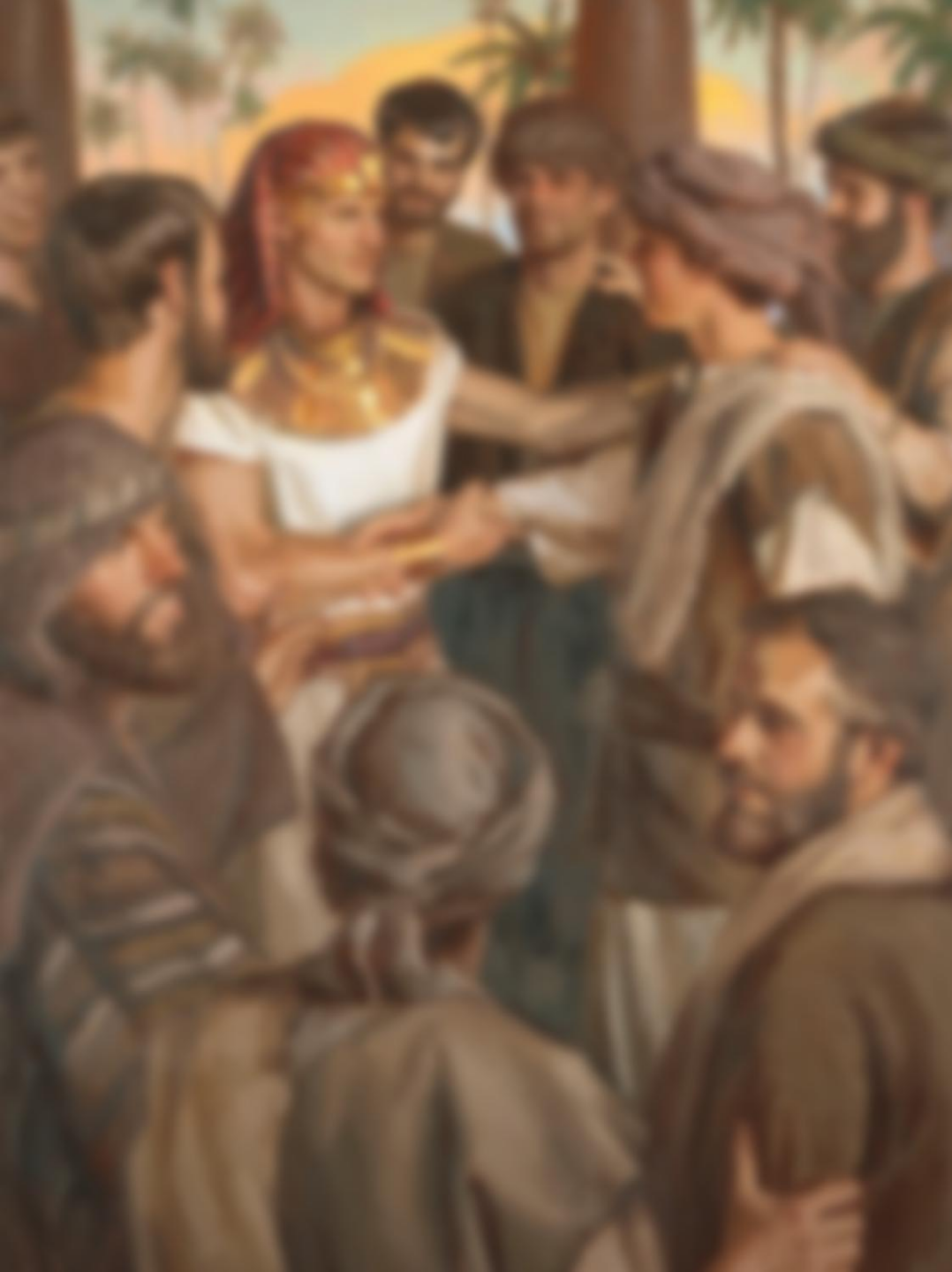
This Old Testament prophet could interpret dreams and eventually became Pharoah's most trusted helper.

This Old Testament prophet was once sold in to slavery in Egypt, and also spent many years in prison after being falsely accused.



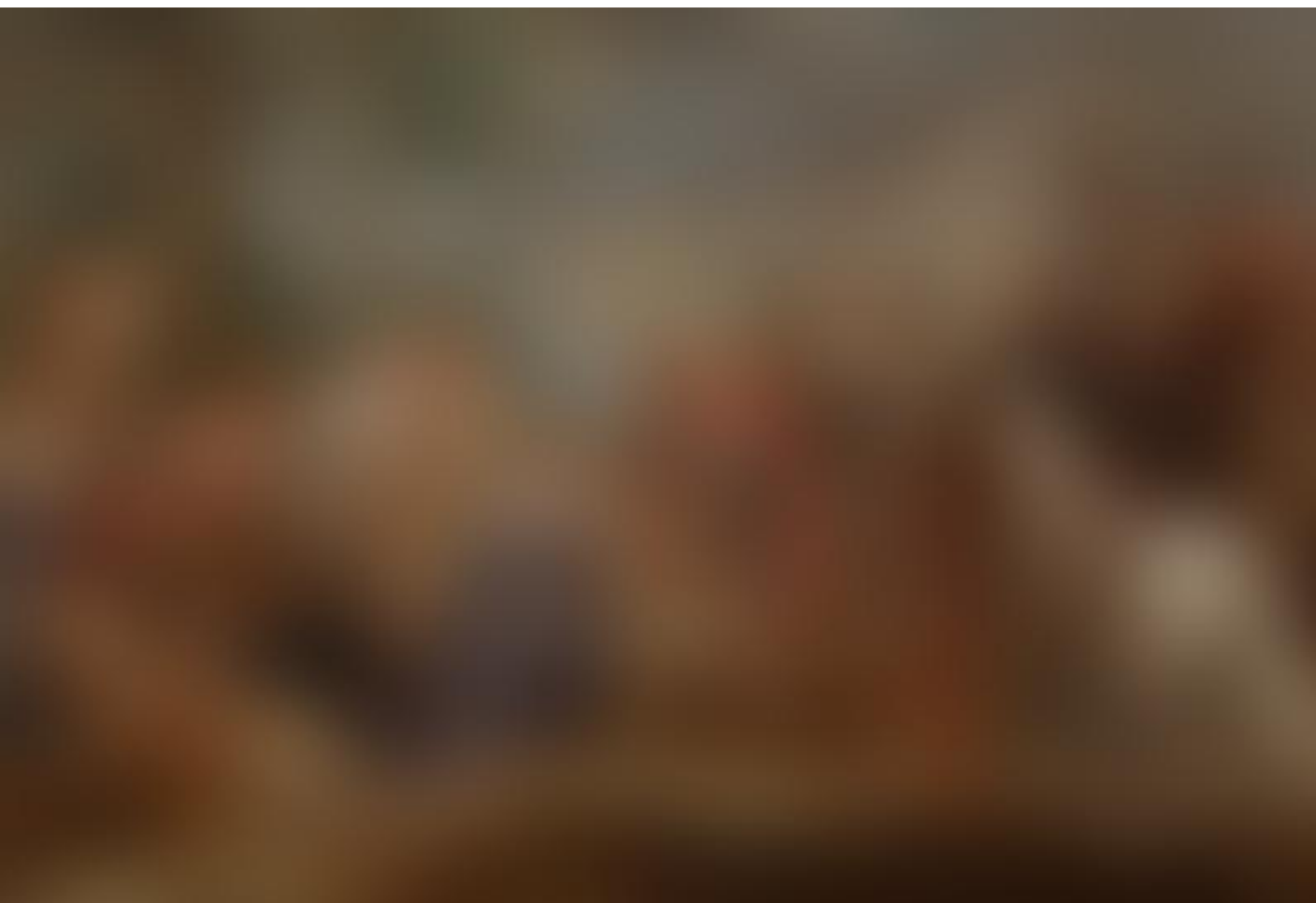
This Old Testament prophet's father loved him so much that he made him a coat of many colors.

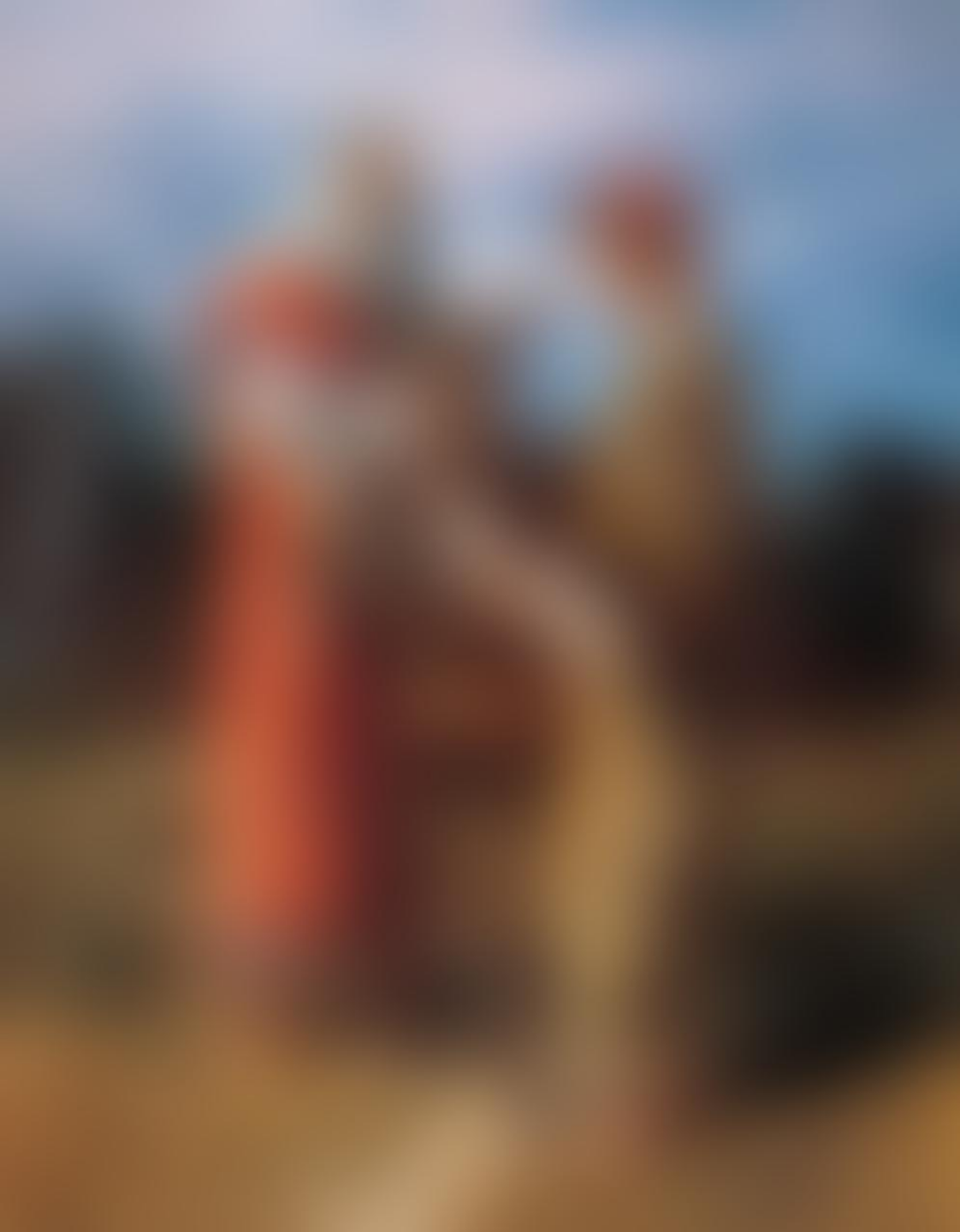

This Old Testament prophet was asked to offer his beloved son Isaac as a sacrifice, but at the last moment, an angel stopped him and saved Isaac.



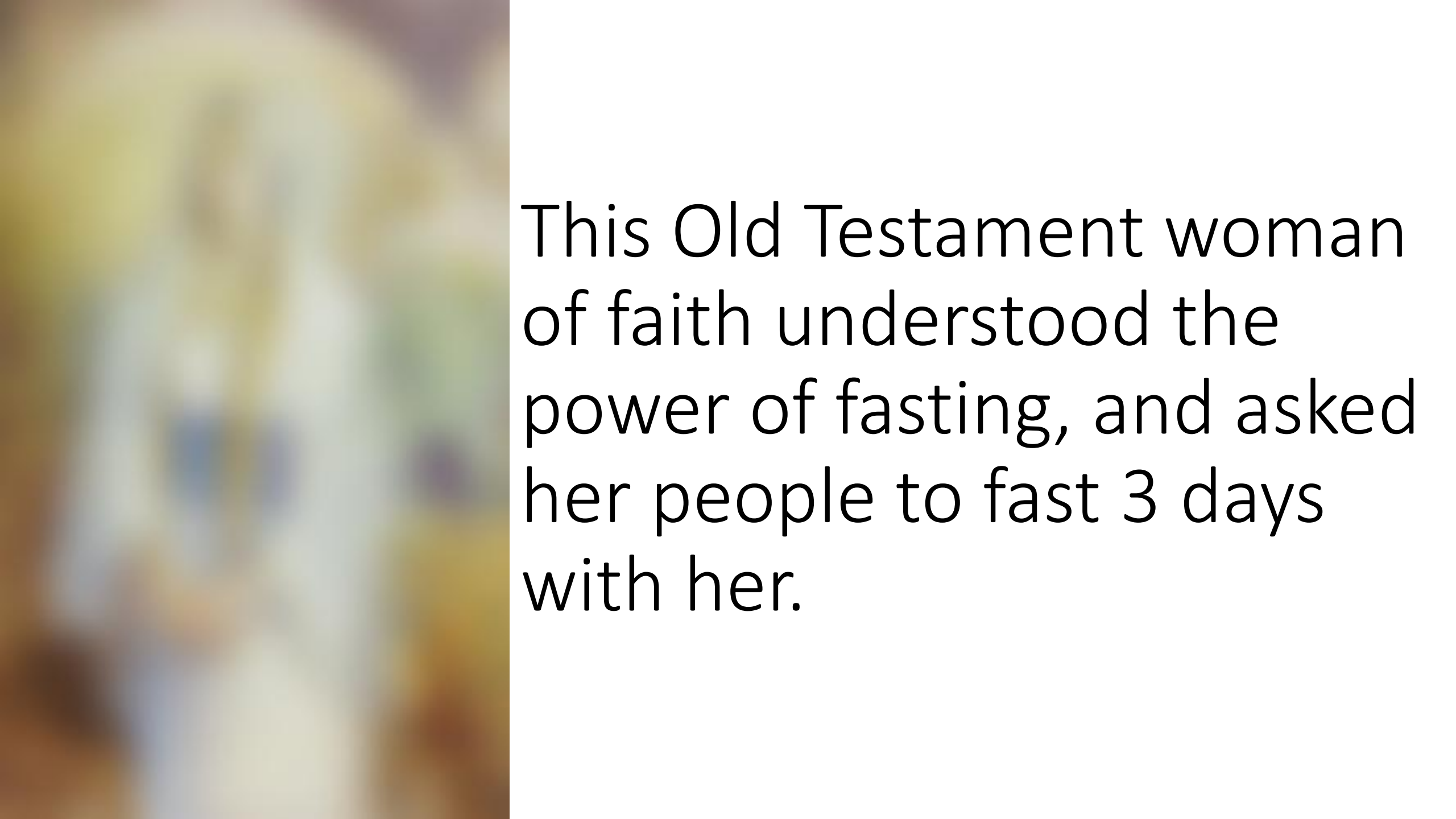
This Old Testament prophet was obedient, and Heavenly Father covenanted that his seed would bless all the families of the earth.

This Old Testament prophet, with his wife, taught his children about the gospel of Jesus Christ, including faith, baptism, the Holy Ghost, and enduring to the end.



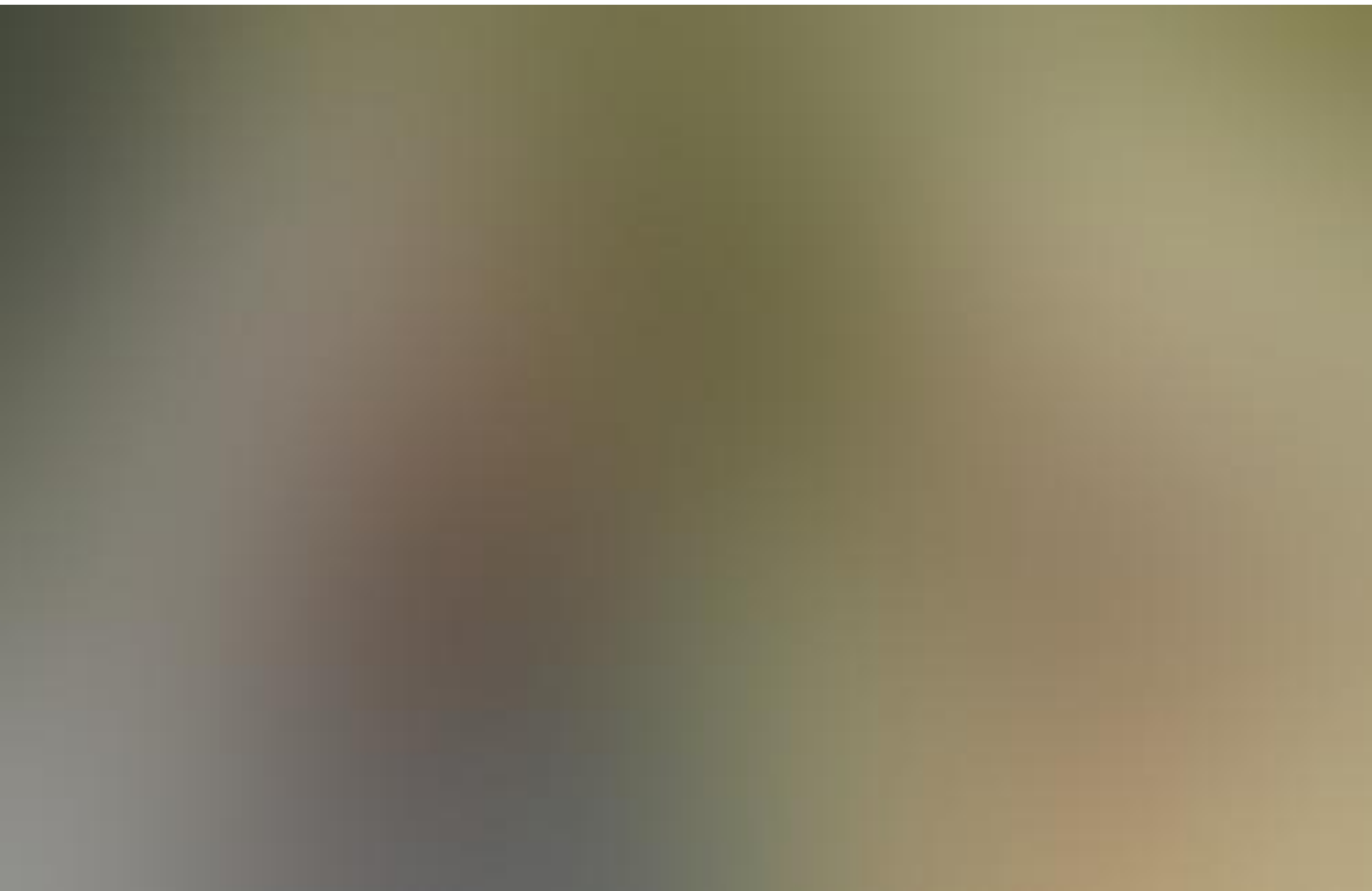

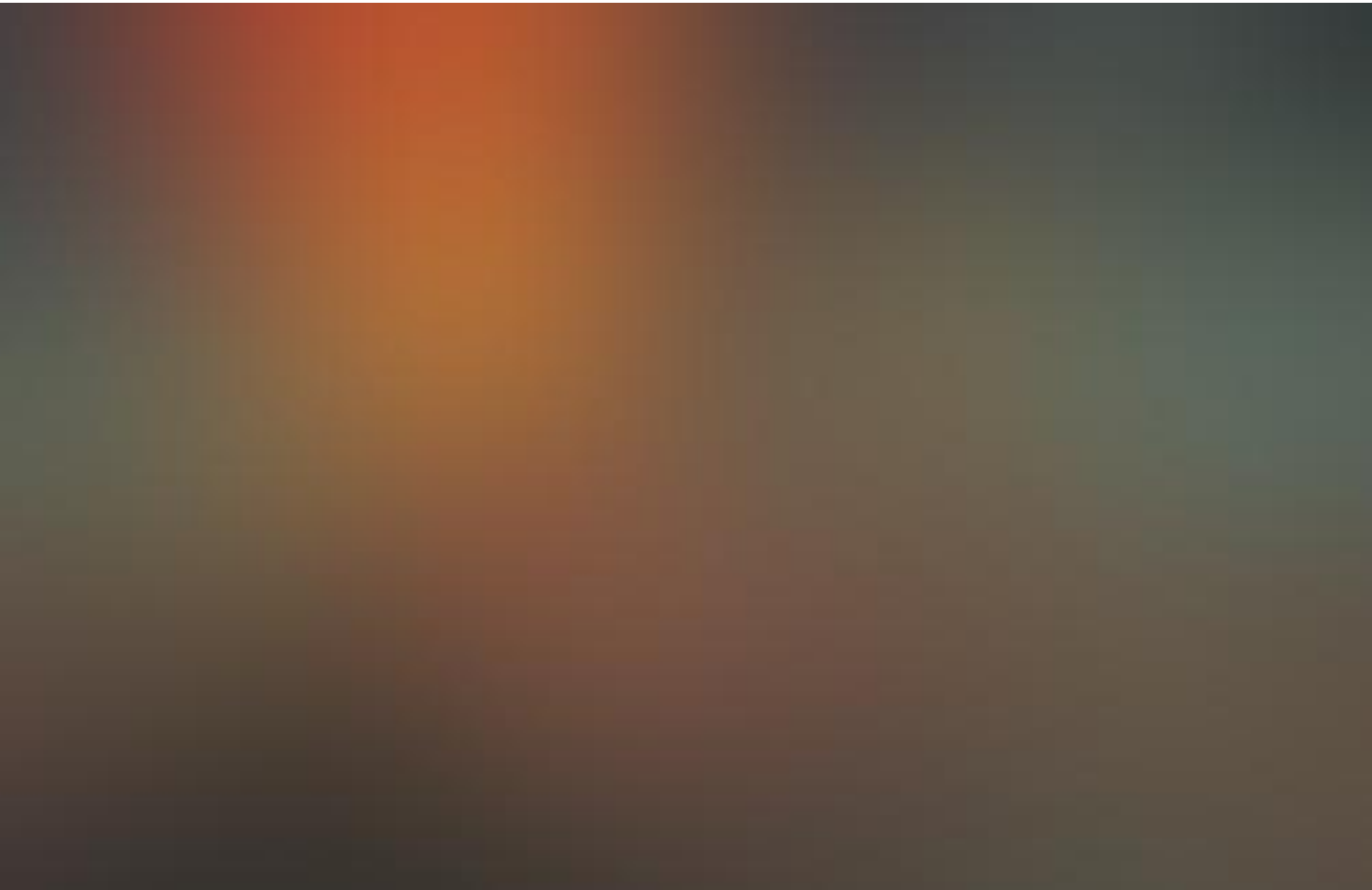

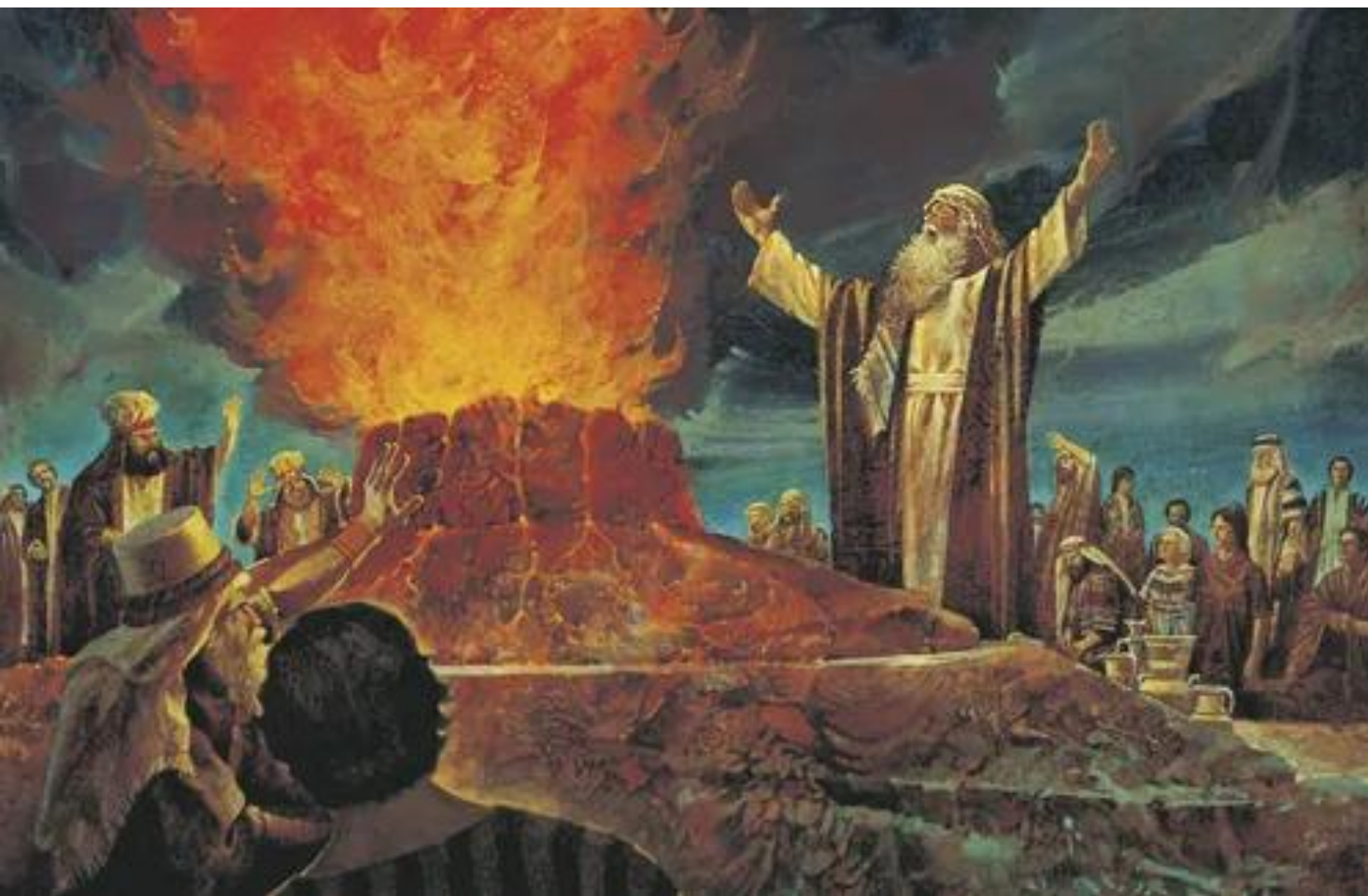

This OT prophet defeated the priests of Baal by calling upon the Lord, who sent down fire that consumed a water-soaked altar.

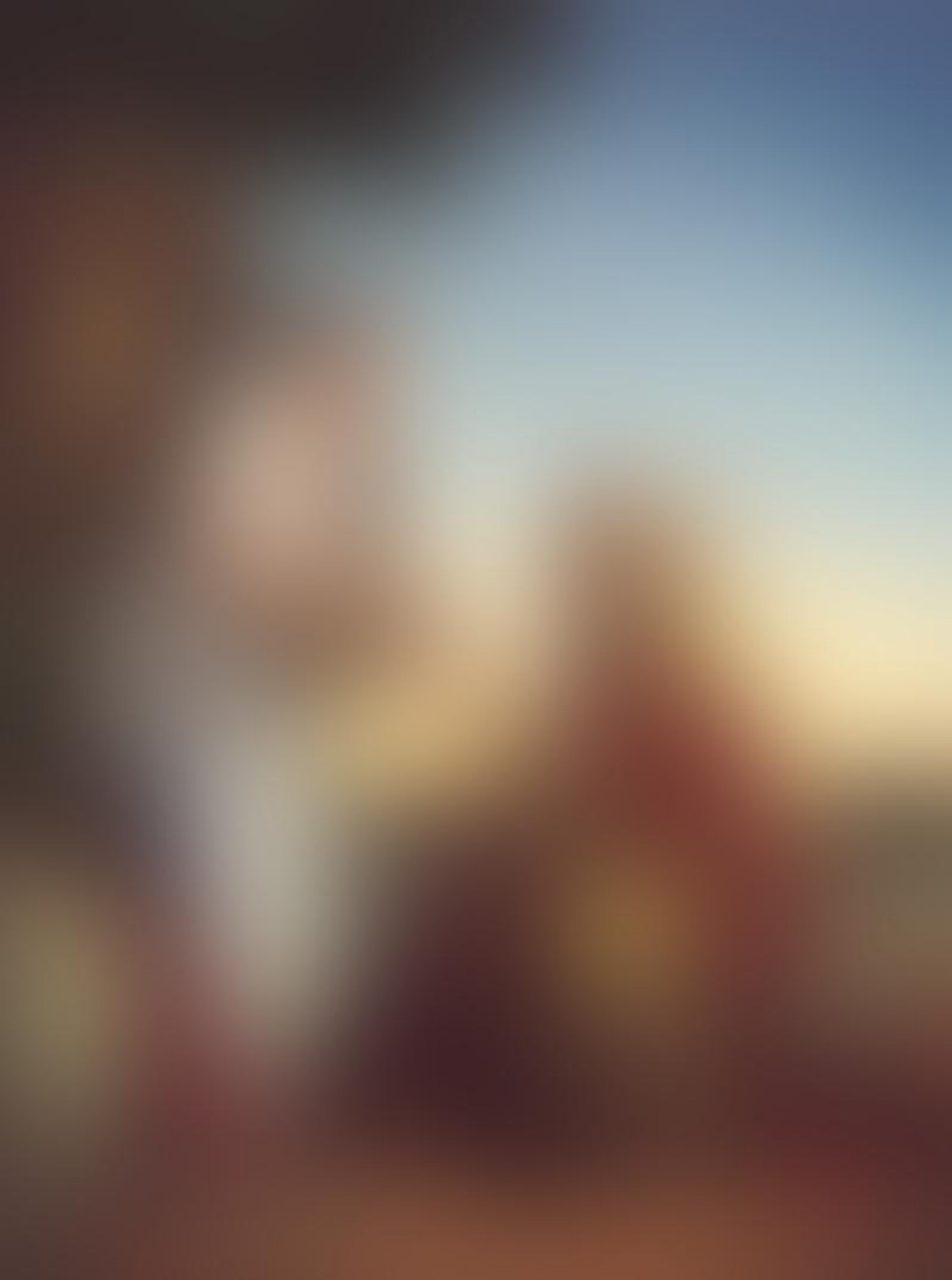


This OT prophet is responsible to “turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers.”

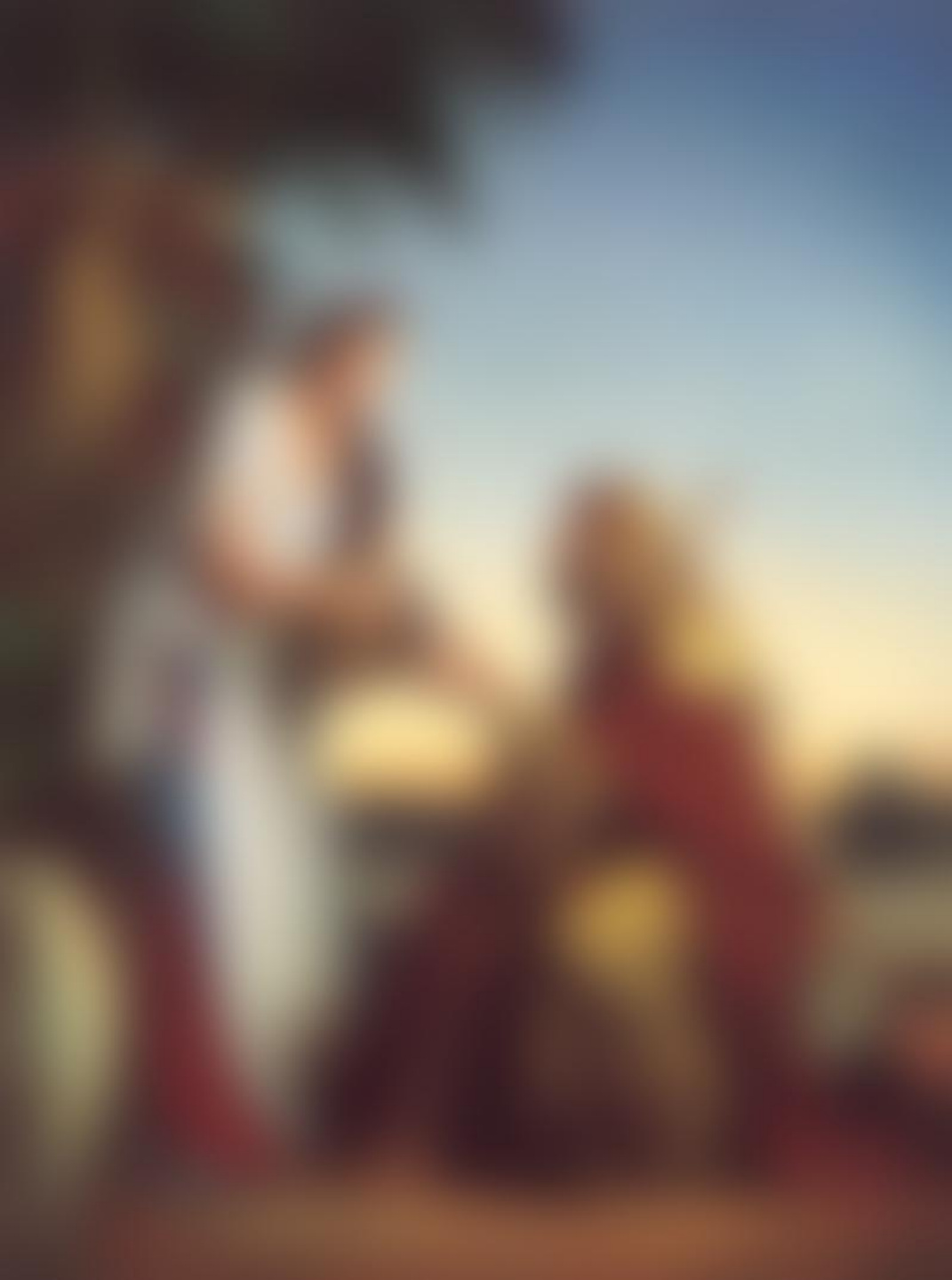

boys.



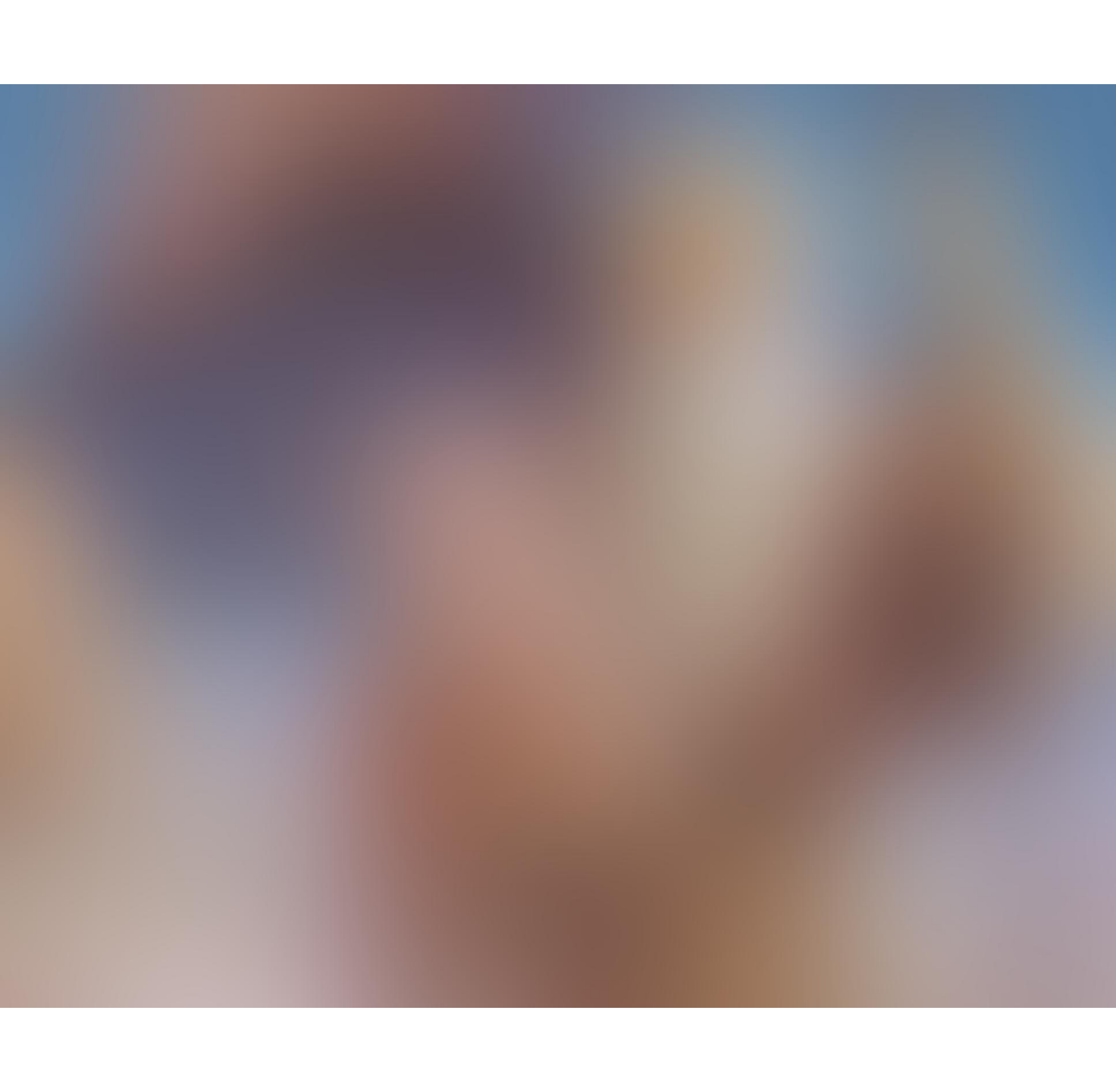
This Old Testament woman of faith was happy to serve and worked hard, doing more than was asked of her, which led her to be selected as a bride to Abraham's son.



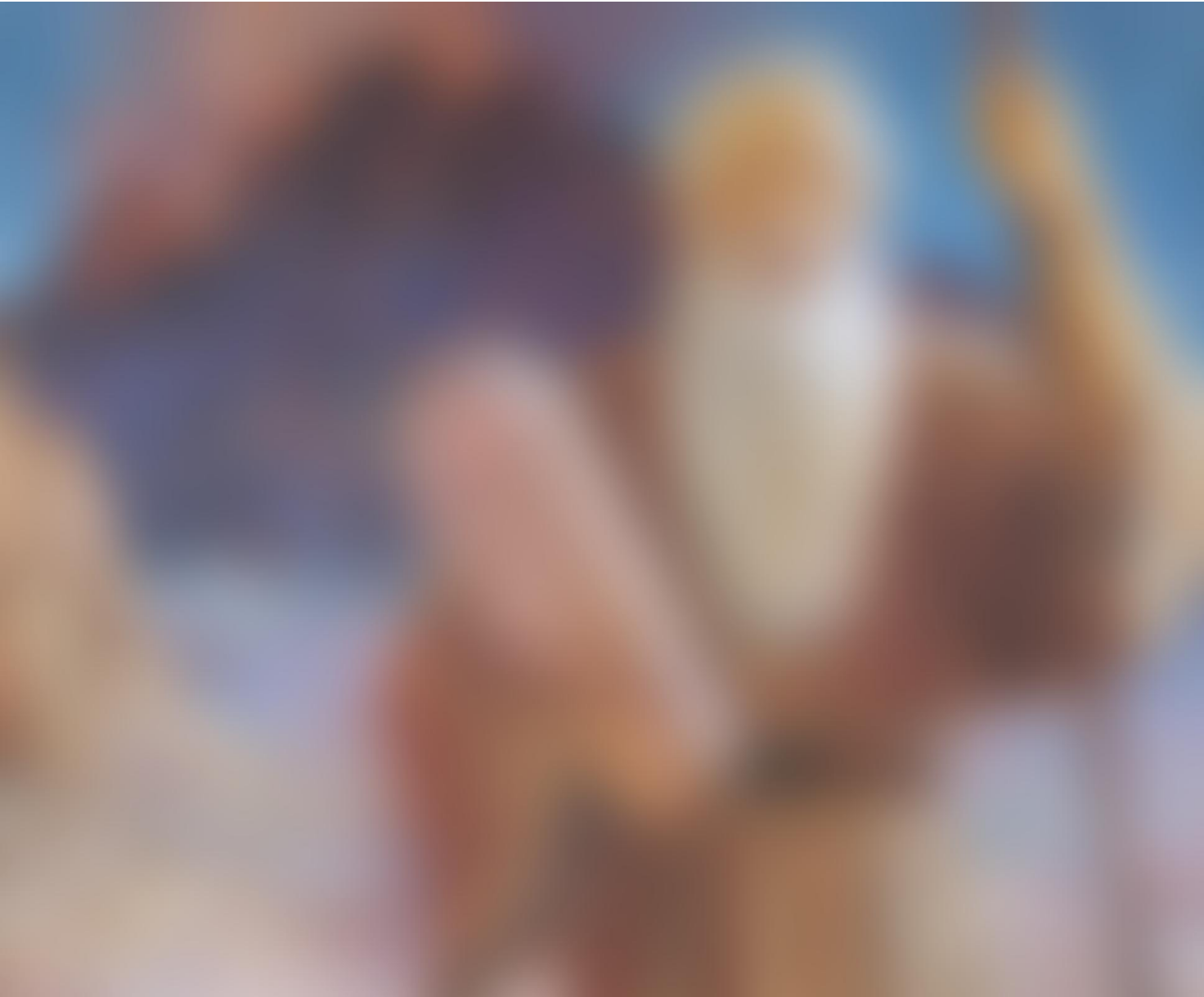

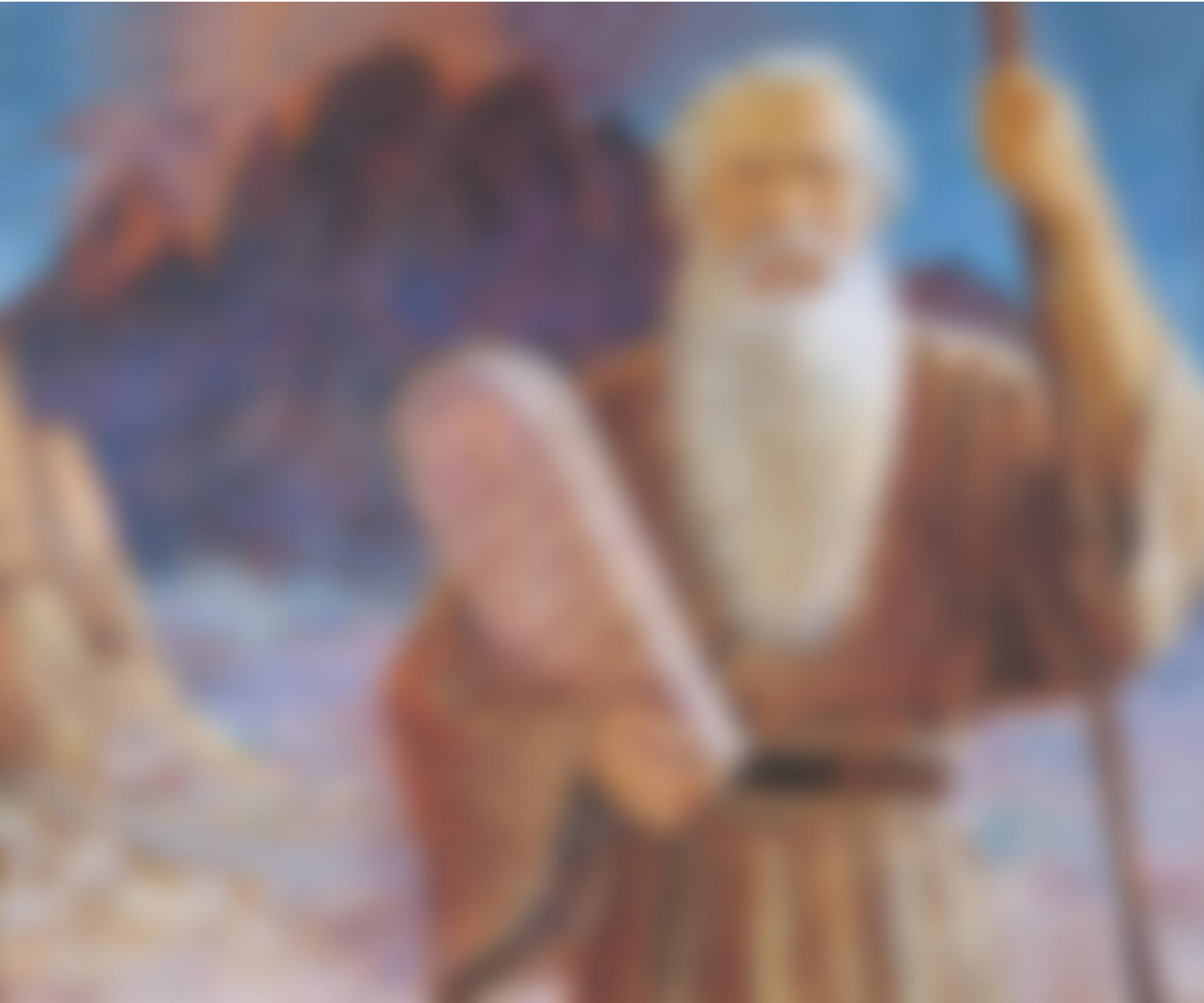
